Music lovers, Galilee residents, dear friends,

Here we are again this summer, hosting large numbers of musicians from all over the world for three weeks of top-quality music-making.

This summer we shall be focusing on **Leopold Mozart**, to mark the 300th anniversary of his birth. We shall familiarize ourselves with the teaching methods he used with his own private child prodigies – his daughter Nannerl and his son Wolfgang Amadeus – and through him we shall take a look at the role of the “tiger parent” in raising gifted children.

In a special workshop led by pianist, composer and conductor **Noam Sivan**, we shall also devote time to the art of cadenza composition for classical concerti. This issue, too, will connect us with Mozart and his contemporaries.

And, of course, we shall also engage in traditional Summer Course activities: individual lessons, masterclasses, playing in chamber ensembles, and concerts every evening.

The events open to the public begin on July 22 and end on August 7 (inclusive). All events are free of charge, apart from the evening concerts in the Bar-Uryan Concert Hall, for which tickets cost 70 shekels, to cover expenses.

We invite you to come to Eilon in Western Galilee and enjoy an exciting musical experience in an international ambiance!
