Dear Friends,

The Keshet Eilon International Music Center is going through a difficult time as a result of the Covid-19 (Coronavirus) crisis. After unavoidable cost-cutting we are left with just enough money to keep the office administration running for the next few months.

The Music Center, which is devoted for 30 years now to nurturing and promoting talented and promising string musicians from both Israel and abroad, is about to founder.

Without sufficient financial means to support our activities, we shall have no choice but to cancel them, including the International Summer Mastercourse.

Donations from generous supporters and public bodies are not arriving, and we are no longer hosting music groups and concert-lovers. Worst of all, fundraising events are being cancelled, and our main benefit concert scheduled for May, which should have served as a vital lifeline for our continued activities, will not now take place, because of the fears engendered by large gatherings.

For three decades now Keshet Eilon's music has never ceased to be heard. Neither tension on the Lebanese border, terrorist attacks, nor military operations in other parts of Israel have ever silenced it. If it falls silent now, it will be very hard to make it heard again, and even harder for it to regain its international recognition and prestige.

If you recognize the vital role that music and culture play in our lives, do not let Keshet Eilon close down. Please come to the aid of Keshet Eilon Music Center. We shall be profoundly grateful for your support and if you be kind enough to spread word of our appeal among family, friends and acquaintances.
